
Corrigendum: Effects of large extra dimensions on cosmogenic neutrino fluxes

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






We did not consider any other type of detector, although the acoustic detection technique is an interesting possibility, and is expected to help in detecting cosmogenic neutrinos [1].

In addition, ARA should be expanded to Askaryan Radio Array (ARA) in the first instance.
